Gang Prevention and Intervention

Though gang activity is not something that is common at Venture, the following provides direction in the event that gang activity begins to make an appearance as such activity is not in the safety interests or wellbeing of our students and community.

- 1. "Gang" is defined as a group of three or more people who form an allegiance and engage in a range of anti-social behaviors that may include violent or unlawful activity or both. These groups may have a name, turf, colors, symbols, or distinct dress, or any combination of the preceding characteristics.
- 2. If gang related actions are noticed, staff will respond with specifically designed projects and activities to help said students stay in school and enhance their cultural and social competence, self-management skills, citizenship, preparation for life skills, academic achievement, literacy, and interpersonal relationship skills required for school completion and positive participation in groups, communities, and society.
